The *Irish Circle of the Lacanian Orientation of the New Lacanian School* (ICLO–NLS) is holding a series of six two-hour open seminars under the title ‘*Returning to Freud (I)*’^(*)

Objective: This course of seminars aims to provide the forum for a close reading and questioning of Freud’s work. They are organised sequentially, following the movement of logical and clinical changes in his theory. The focus is on introducing and deepening participants’ understanding of Freud’s ideas, from his pre-psychoanalytic writings to his later works.
