



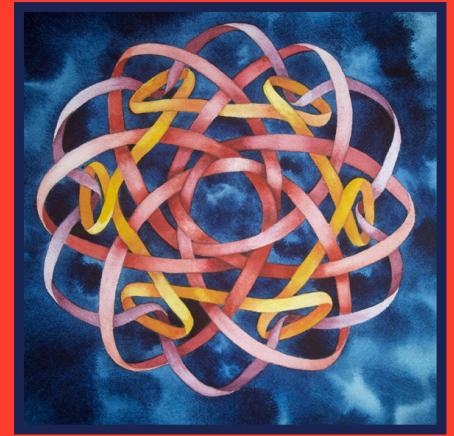
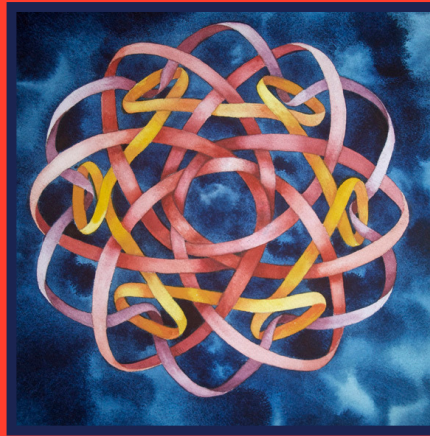
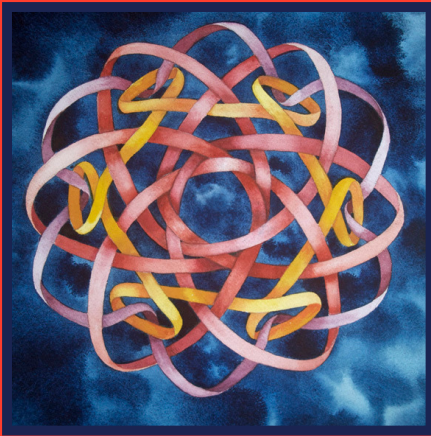

## **THE POLITICS OF THE SYMPTOM with Neus Carbonell**

Psychoanalysis has been since Freud a treatment of the malaise in civilization. What is its place today? The politics of the symptom is an expression used in Lacanian psychoanalysis to underline the fact that the symptom has its own politics. That is to say, jouissance always fails to produce an adaptation of the subject to the real. The symptom is the result of this failure. Therefore, the politics of psychoanalysis always deals with this failure. In this talk we will try to unravel the consequences of this expression, as well as of others such as “the unconscious is the politics” for a subject in analysis, for the School of Psychoanalysis as well as for an understanding of contemporary forms of malaise. In this way, we hope to shed some light over the contributions of Lacanian psychoanalysis to the understanding of the economy of jouissance .
